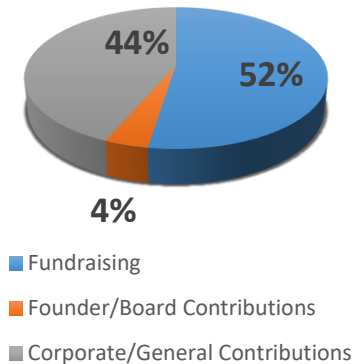

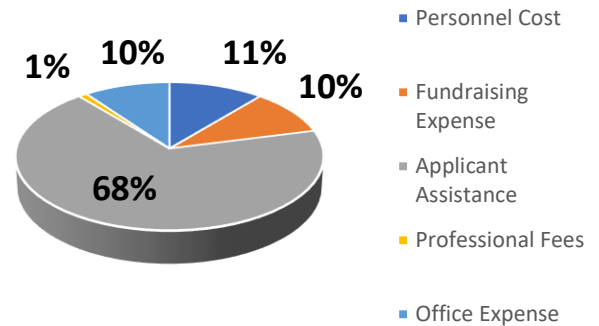
Hope Station has assisted with homeless prevention and emergency utility assistance to more than 300 mothers and their children in Davidson and Rutherford Counties since 2016?
